FAQ for SKÅL Northeast USA Regional Event

Q: Why should I attend the SKÅL Northeast USA regional event?

Q: Where will events take place for the Jan. 2025 SKÅL Regional?

A: All meals, meetings and activities will take place at various locations at American Dream Shopping and Entertainment Complex in East Rutherford, NJ. More details on exact locations for our reception, restaurants, and general meeting will be provided to those that register for the event.

Q: What is American Dream and is it easily accessible?

A: With nearly 3 million square feet of retail space, American Dream is the largest retail and entertainment complex in the USA! It is adjacent to the Meadowlands Sports Complex in East Rutherford, NJ. With a central location in Northern New Jersey, it lies within 20 minutes of Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR) and can be seen just off I-95 Exit 16. This venue was chosen for its central location and excellent accessibility in Northeast USA.

American Dream is less than 25 minutes from NY Port Authority / Lincoln Tunnel and less than 20 minutes from George Washington Bridge and (EWR) Newark Liberty International Airport. From NYC, a shuttle operates daily to Meadowlands from Port Authority.

Coming from Philly, DC or Baltimore by train, Secaucus Train Station is closest (just a short 10–15-minute shuttle or Uber ride).

Q: Why was the Hilton Meadowlands chosen as the host hotel?
